STEP ONE: THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS IS HOW YOU BEGIN

- Apply to Tri-County Technical College with a major of Associate Degree Nursing at www.tctc.edu/apply
- Complete the required placement tests
- Schedule an appointment with a Student Success Coach
- Submit official high school and college transcripts to Admissions
- Review the curriculum guide for your program at https://www.tctc.edu/programs/career-programs/nursing/
- Begin taking Science, English and Math pre-requisites
- Meet with your nursing advisor information under Get Set Tab. Call (864) 646-1400 if your advisor has not been assigned
- Log on to eTC from www.tctc.edu for College email account, the Academic Calendar and other important information

STEP TWO: QUALIFYING FOR NURSING CLINICAL ENTRY APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY

- ATI TEAS Test information is available at https://www.tctc.edu/programs/career-programs/nursing/
- Achieve the minimum TEAS Adjusted Individual Test Score (AITS) of 64% or higher
- ATI TEAS test scores expire 3 years after test date
- Have completed ENG 101, MAT 120, and BIO 101 prior to start date, and have completed BIO 210 (Anatomy and Physiology I), or be registered (BIO 101 is a pre-requisite)
- Have a 2.5 minimum GPA. TCTC GPA supersedes all other GPAs. If a student has no TCTC GPA, the overall transfer GPA will be considered.

STEP THREE: SUBMIT THE NURSING CLINICAL ENTRY APPLICATION FOR A CLINICAL SEAT

- Nursing application is available on eTC under the "Get Set" tab. A confirmation email will be sent to your TCTC college
 e-mail account once the application has been submitted correctly.
