### **STEP ONE: APPLY TO THE COLLEGE BY COMPLETING THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS**

- Apply to Tri-County Technical College with a major of Associate Degree Transition Nursing at [www.tctc.edu/apply](http://www.tctc.edu/apply)
- Complete the required placement tests
- Schedule an appointment with a Student Success Coach
- Submit official high school and college transcripts to Admissions
- Review the curriculum guide for your program <https://www.tctc.edu/programs/career-programs/nursing/>
- Continue taking Science, English and Math pre-requisites
- Meet with your nursing advisor – information under Get Set Tab. Call (864) 646-1400 if your advisor has not been assigned.
- Log onto eTC from [www.tctc.edu](http://www.tctc.edu) to review the Academic Calendar, your college email account and other important information

### **STEP TWO: QUALIFYING FOR NURSING CLINICAL ENTRY APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY**

- ATI TEAS Test information is available at <https://www.tctc.edu/programs/career-programs/nursing/>
- Achieve the minimum TEAS Adjusted Individual Test Score (AITS) of 50% or higher
- ATI RN Fundamentals Exam Information is available at <https://www.tctc.edu/programs/career-programs/nursing/>
- Achieve a Level 2 or higher on the ATI RN Fundamentals Exam
- ATI TEAS test and ATI Fundamentals Nursing test scores expire 3 years after test date
- Have completed ENG 101, MAT 120, and BIO 101 prior to start date, and have completed BIO 210 (Anatomy and Physiology I), or be registered (BIO 101 is a pre-requisite)
- Have a 2.5 minimum GPA. TCTC GPA supersedes all other GPAs. If a student has no TCTC GPA, the overall transfer GPA will be considered.

- LPN license must be a current and unencumbered Multi state license
- LPN Nursing Education must be from a nationally (ACEN) credentialed college/program
- Paramedics require an Associate in Applied Science Degree

### **STEP THREE: SUBMIT THE NURSING CLINICAL ENTRY APPLICATION FOR A CLINICAL SEAT**
